A) Avec subst. des bornes

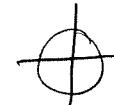
$$u = 2\pi(x-2)$$

$$du = 2\pi dx$$

$$x_0 = 2 \Rightarrow u_0 = 2\pi(x_0 - 2) = 0$$

$$x_1 = 5 \quad u_1 = 2\pi(x_1 - 2) = 6\pi$$

$$\int_2^5 \cos(2\pi(x-2)) dx = \frac{1}{2\pi} \int_{0}^{6\pi} \cos(u) du = \frac{1}{2\pi} \sin(u) \Big|_0^{6\pi} = \frac{1}{2\pi} \underbrace{\sin 6\pi}_{=0} - \frac{1}{2\pi} \underbrace{\sin 0}_{=0} = 0$$

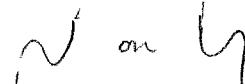

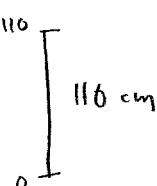

Densité linéaire :  $\rho(z) = e^{-0,001z}$

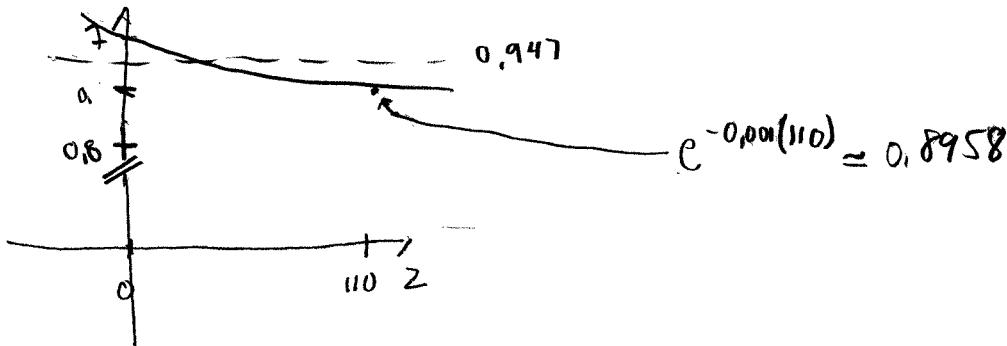
[ $\frac{\text{g}}{\text{cm}}$ ]

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Masse totale : } M &= \int_0^{110} e^{-0,001z} dz \\ &= \int_0^{-0,11} \frac{e^u}{-0,001} du \\ &= -1000 e^u \Big|_0^{-0,11} = -1000 (e^{-0,11} - e^0) = -1000 (e^{-0,11} - 1) \approx 104,17 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} u &= -0,001z \\ du &= -0,001 dz \\ u_0 &= 0 \\ u_1 &= -0,001 \cdot 110 = -0,11 \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} Qte &= \int_0^2 \frac{dC}{dt} dt = \int_0^2 t e^{-t} dt && \text{par parties } \int u dv = uv - \int v du \\ &&& u=t \quad dv=e^{-t} \quad u_0=0 \\ &&& du=dt \quad v=-e^{-t} \quad u_1=2 \\ &= -t e^{-t} \Big|_0^2 + \int_0^2 e^{-t} dt && \int e^{-t} dt = -e^{-t} \Big|_0^2 \\ &= -t e^{-t} \Big|_0^2 - e^{-t} \Big|_0^2 && -[-e^{-t}] \Big|_0^2 \end{aligned}$$

Qte totale = Qte initiale + Qte produite entre  $t=0$  et  $t=a$

$$\Rightarrow \text{Qte totale} = -3e^{-2} + 1$$

Applications Nb d'individus densité  $f(x) = 3 \cdot 10^{-4} x (1000-x)$   $0 < x < 1000$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Nb total} &= \int_0^{1000} 3 \cdot 10^{-4} x (1000-x) dx = 3 \cdot 10^{-4} \int_0^{1000} 1000x - x^2 dx \\ &= 3 \cdot 10^{-4} \left( 1000 \frac{x^2}{2} - \frac{x^3}{3} \right)_0^{1000} \\ &= 3 \cdot 10^{-4} \left( 500 \cdot 1000^2 - \frac{1}{3} (1000)^3 \right) \\ &= 3 \cdot 10^{-4} (5 \cdot 10^8 - \frac{1}{3} \cdot 10^9) \\ &= 15 \cdot 10^4 - 1 \cdot 10^5 \\ &= 1.5 \cdot 10^5 - 1 \cdot 10^5 \\ &= 5 \cdot 10^4 \text{ autres} \end{aligned}$$

Densité moyenne :  $\frac{1}{1000} \cdot 5 \cdot 10^4 = 5 \left[ \frac{\text{autres}}{\text{mille}} \right]$
