Introduction

Waves model (Boussinesq, Saint-Venant)

- Unable to represent complex free surface (multi-connected domains)
- Can represent sloshing with damping [Benoit 02, Yu 99]
- Studies shows the necessity of more physical models [Duthyk 10]

Sloshing representation (VOF, SPH)

- Waves damping (can be handled by *ad-hoc* treatment)
- Computational coast (3D computations un-reachable)

BSQ_V2P3 implements:

- Physical description
 - \frown wave height η
 - horizontal velocity u
 - \checkmark reference height z_{α}
- ← Finite difference discretization $(\mathcal{O}(\Delta x^4))$
- ← Explicit Predictor $(\mathcal{O}(\Delta t^3))$ Corrector $(\mathcal{O}(\Delta t^4))$ time integration scheme

Wave component: Compilation gives:

- A library: call like a lib, thread (asynchronous calls)
- An executable: remote call with tcp, pipe, MPI...
- Multiscale [Hautefeuille 09], EFEM [Benkemoun 09]
 Stochastic [Krosche 09], Thermomechanics [Kassiotis 06], Mass transfer [De Sa 08], FSI [Kassiotis 09] ...

SPH component:

- Interface definition: derivated from existing CFDsimu.ci:
- Implemented ofoam [Krosche 07, Kassiotis 09] in C++
- Methods declaration
