Integration methods

1. Integration by substation (change of variables), Integration by parts. Calculation of definite and indefinite integrals

Differential equations

- 1. First order linear homogenous and non-homogenous differential equations, Bernoulli's equation and Riccati equation.
- 2. Linear equations of second order homogenous and non-homogenous differential equations with constant coefficients.
